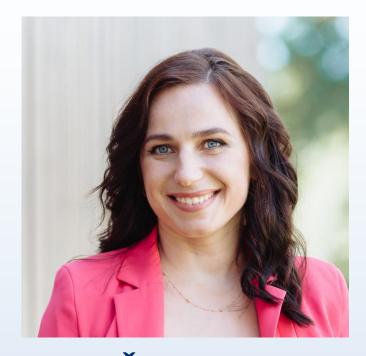

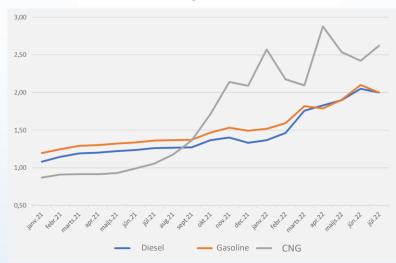




"PERFECT STORM" IN ENERGY SECTOR

Fuel

Retail fuel price EUR / litre



- After adjusting to Covid-19, the economy and demand for oil are growing
- Oil production remains limited
- Migration away from Russian oil reduces supply
- A possible recession in the world economy may decrease fuel prices

Electricity

Electricity price EUR / Mwh



- Lack of cost-effective capacities (renewable energy) in the Baltics
- Natural gas cogeneration plants have not been operating since February
- The cost of fossil resources (natural gas and oil)
 is affected by the high prices of CO2 quotas
- Normalization of prices within 1-2 years

- **Geopolitical events** have created significant pressure on the price of fuel products
- Latvia has the **highest excise duty rate** in the Baltics
- Legislative changes waiver of the **mandatory biocomponent** in fuel starting from July 1
 - Increase in retail fuel sales in Latvia by +2.2% (Virši network +8.9%)
- Demand for **alternative fuels** continues to grow (CNG volumes in the Virši network +68.6%)

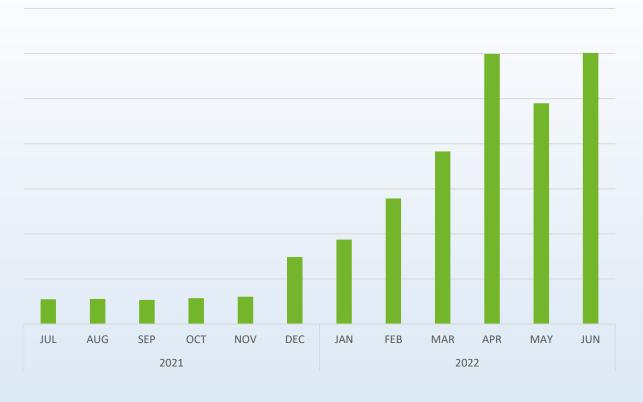

ELECTRICITY TRADE TRENDS IN 6 MONTHS OF 2022

Growth in the volume of purchased and sold electricity



- Active work with independent electricity producers (water, solar, biomass, biogas plants) located in Latvia.
- On June 1, the **first year** as an electricity trader
- The amount of purchased/sold energy reached 25,000
 Mwh in 6 months
- Successful work in the electricity wholesale market, providing the Group with electricity costs significantly below market prices
- Around 40 customers (primarily B2B) are served with more than 300 connection points throughout Latvia

- **Turnover increase** by 60% has been led by 7 new fuel stations that extended Group's network within 12 months and the price increase in fuel products by 53%.
- Gross margin for reporting period is 10.6% (2021: 12.2%) that decreased due to fuel resource availability and pricing in the first half of the year.
 - The company continues to pursue a thorough cost planning policy and adapts quickly to new market situations, both by adjusting sales channels and by monitoring costs.
- retwork expansion, offer planning in Convenience stores and sales of fuel and energy products increasing gross profit by 4.5m EUR or +38%.
- A financial instrument related to the purchase and price fixing of electricity, primarily for the period from 2023-2027, is recognized in finance income. Net value increase for period amounted to 1.5m EUR.

- CAPEX and investments in associates reached 8.9m EUR mainly the expansion of the fuel station network, and continuos work on development of biomethane and CNG trade and logistics solutions.
- Since 2022, the Group devotes significant resources to IT strategy and development.
- Main source of funding in reporting period was 7m EUR loan in SEB bank, cash flow form operating activities and capital raised on the stock exchange in 2021.
- Operating activities in reporting period were related to focused plan of working capital. Physical and financial planning were affected by resource price fluctuations, logistics chain planning, resource availability and the unceratinty in regulations related to bio component requirements in Latvia.
- A financial instrument related to the purchase and price fixing of electricity for the period from 2023-2027 is recognized as an asset and liability in the balance sheet. Assets 12.5m EUR, liabilities 9.9m EUR.

- Since 11 November 2021, Virši shares have been listed on the stock exchange. IPO raised net 7.3 m EUR for further strategic development.
- Dividends for 2021 were distributed according to the Group's policy – 20% of the consolidated net profits. The decision on profit distribution for 2022 will be voted after the end of the financial year.
- The company has attracted financing for the development of the fuel station network in SEB bank in the amount of 7 million euros.
- Liquidity ratios are stable CA/CL 1.24
 (2021 corresponding period: 1.1)
- Earnings per share in the period reached
 0.37 euros (0.20 euros in the corresponding period of 2021)
